Supervision of Children on site

We have had a number of cases of children losing their parents either at the start of the day or at the end of school. Parents are responsible for supervising their children at all times when on site, before delivering them to school in the mornings or collecting them from teachers in the afternoons. Please ensure that your child is with you **at all times**.

There have also been instances of poor behaviour by some unsupervised children. This involves running into the drive when cars are approaching, damage to school property, and generally unacceptable behaviour. Again it is the parents' responsibility to supervise the children and ensure that they do not behave in an unacceptable manner when on school property.

Parking

Yet again we have problems with inconsiderate parking around the streets close to school. I have been informed that there have been a number of comments on social media sites about this. Please can I remind all parents to park sensibly and considerately around school approaches. The near residents understandably get very frustrated by having their drive ways obstructed, and pedestrians are frustrated by cars being parked on the pavements. I have been informed that there will be increased presence of community police officers around school in the next few weeks to ensure that everyone connected with our school is behaving in a responsible manner when parking cars.
