Democracy

- Our School Council meets to talk about school life
- All children in school are able to share their views with peers and adults
- Where decisions are to be made, each class member has a vote to ensure their opinion is heard

The Rule of Law

- Each class decides on a set of rules at the beginning of each year
- Rules are revisited regularly during PSHE lessons
- Rules are displayed in each classroom
- We have clear sanctions for broken rules

Individual Liberty
