

Rainbow Reading Chart

In order to encourage our children to regularly read at home we have a rainbow reading reward scheme in school which rewards those children who read each week with an adult at home.

Your child has their own rainbow chart in school on which they can collect one smiley face a week. A smiley face is given to each child who has read their **school reading book** to an adult at home during the week and has one comment and signature from an adult in their reading diary.

As your child fills each column of the rainbow with smiley faces they will collect merit cards to bring home and once completed will receive a rainbow reader certificate in assembly and a team point for their class.

Once your child completes the rainbow reader chart they will move on to the golden reader chart to complete similarly to receive a golden reader certificate.

Please help us support your child by listening to them read their **school reading book** at home on a regular basis and to write and sign one comment in their reading diary once a week. (Please note that each child will receive one smiley face for the week not one for each comment that is made. We also ask that comments are made by an adult rather than an older sibling).
