



Autumn Term 2024 After School Curriculum Club Offer

Friday 6th September 2024

Dear parents and carers,

Our curriculum club offer is to support children's broader development beyond the school day.

Some of the clubs on offer are led by external providers and some of the clubs on offer are led by school staff.

This term, we will offer clubs to our Key Stage 1 (Years 1 and 2) children. We will broaden our offer to enable Reception children to join our clubs in the spring term when they have settled into the school routine.

Our club offer is open to all Year 1 and Year 2 children and we are hoping to encourage and inspire children to discover and develop their talents and interests. We would like to kindly ask that parents and carers of children with additional needs talk to their child's class teacher about club interests before requesting or booking places. This is so that we can enable all children to be happy and succeed with the necessary level of support.

Clubs led by external providers are to be booked directly with the external providers by following the instructions on the linked letters/flyers.

Rock Steady Club is an ongoing club with a monthly charge. Jumping Clay Club is a half-termly club and will run until October half term before parents and carers can book again for the second half of the autumn term. Our external provider led clubs run all year round. Last year they were thoroughly enjoyed by the children who attended. It was amazing to see children develop and succeed.

School led clubs are termly clubs and will run until the Christmas holiday when a new spring term club offer will be shared. Christmas Club will begin in November for six weeks. School led clubs are subsidised by the school. There is a small standard charge of £3.00 a week to contribute towards the staffing costs. For Art Club and Christmas Club there is an enhanced charge of £3.50 a week to contribute towards the staffing costs and the cost of resources. Payments should be made during the week beginning Monday 16th September via Parent Pay. To secure a club place, it is necessary to pay for the block of weeks, irrespective of children's attendance.

We are able to offer a limited number of school funded club places to children who are eligible for benefits related free school meals. Class teachers will approach parents discreetly to offer places to eligible children who show interest in particular clubs. It's important that our enrichment opportunities are fully inclusive.

To request places, complete the request form and return to school by Monday 9th September. You will know if your child has been allocated a club place on Monday 16th September. Payments will be expected during the week beginning Monday 16th September via Parent Pay.

We are able to offer up to 26 places in each of our school led clubs. We require a minimum of 8 paid places for a club to go ahead. If more than 26 places for a club are requested, we will operate a waiting list system. Children on the waiting list for a club will be prioritised for a place the following term.

We are asking parents and carers of after school curriculum clubs NOT to drive or park on site. We cannot safely accommodate so many vehicles on site at the same time. Our after school curriculum clubs all finish at 4:10pm:

- Musical Theatre on a Monday
- Art Club, Football Club and Rock Steady on a Tuesday
- Gardening Club on a Wednesday
- Jumping Clay Club on a Thursday
- Dance Club on a Friday

Parents and carers collecting children from the above after school curriculum clubs will need to park safely and considerately in the community and then walk on site and up to school for 4:10pm.

Please allow sufficient time to drive and park safely before collecting your child from an after school curriculum club. Mr Roberts is our Site Manager and he will be supporting our driving and parking expectations. Please be considerate and patient.


